

## Using the proximity function

The prox function is compatible with all Texecom prox enabled products. The SmartKey function is compatible with all *Ricochet*® enabled systems (excludes Premier Elite iXP-W).

1. The Premier Elite SmartKey prox symbol () must be held over the prox symbol PROX on the keypad or iProx unit.


 The Premier Elite SmartKey prox function will normally work at distances of up to 3cm, however it should be noted that distances can and do vary.



 Presenting the Premier Elite SmartKey to the keypad is the same as entering a code except that it is a single action as opposed to a multiple action.

4. The control panel will log which user/SmartKey has been presented.

To program the prox function please refer to a prox enabled keypad manual, Premier Elite iProx manual, Premier user guide or the Premier Elite user guide.
